Job Purpose

The Warehouseperson I will assist the Supervisor and other departmental personnel with the daily operations of the warehouse. This position will perform shipping, receiving, stocking, spot counts and issuing tools and materials to personnel while maintaining the warehouse in a safe and orderly fashion.

Essential Functions

- 1. Receive material and verify quantity and description of material delivered to the Cooperative.
- 2. Accurately place materials on shelves, racks or other designated storage areas in an orderly manner, keeping the warehouse organized at all times.
- 3. Assist with quarterly and annual inventory counts as listed on the cycle list. Ensure that inventory is at the established quantity levels.
- 4. Assist with maintenance and record keeping requirements for ground chains, hot sticks and rubber goods.
- 5. Issue and deliver materials to field crews.
- 6. Performs other duties as required and/or assigned.
