### **EXPERIMENTAL TARIFF**

#### **50% and 100% Renewable Rate Rider**

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##### **Eligibility and Availability**

This rate rider ("Rider") is available, on a voluntary basis to Trico Electric Cooperative, Inc. ("Trico" or the "Cooperative") Customers within Trico's Certificated Area who want to purchase energy from renewable resources to cover either 50% or 100% of their energy usage; except for Customers excluded herein. Participation will be limited to 1,000 Customers.

This Rider is not available to the following Customers:

1. Customers on Trico's GS-4 Tariff
2. Customers on Trico's Net Metering, Sun Watts Sun Farm, or DG Energy Tariffs

This Rider also is not available for resale, breakdown, temporary, standby, auxiliary service, or service to electrical equipment that causes excessive voltage fluctuations.

The standard Rules, Regulations and Line Extension Policies of the Cooperative, as on file and updated from time to time with the Arizona Corporation Commission, shall apply where not inconsistent with this Rider.

##### **Description**

This Rider allows a Customer to purchase energy generated by a renewable resource ("Renewable Power") facilitated by the Cooperative, in an amount sufficient to cover either 50% or 100% of the Customer's total monthly kWh usage. This Renewable Power may be generated from any resource designated by Trico as renewable, including renewable energy credits ("REC") collected, held, or purchased by Trico. Trico may use RECs collected, held, or purchased by Trico to cover the Usage Subject to Rider (defined below).

##### **Eligibility and Application**

To participate the Customer must make a request and complete an Application. Customer's eligibility to take service under this Rider and available Renewable Power shall be determined at the sole discretion of Trico.

Service under this Rider will commence on the first day of the next billing cycle after Trico approves Customer's Application, confirms the option selected by Customer, and determines that the Customer is eligible to participate under the Rider.

## **Monthly Rate Rider**

Trico purchases, owns, or has rights to Renewable Power. Annually, Trico will calculate the percentage of its retail sales that are served by Renewable Power and publish that calculation ("Annual Trico Renewable Percentage"). Each month, to determine the amount of kWh usage to which this Rider will apply, Trico will calculate Customer's monthly usage minus the proportion of Customer's monthly usage covered by the Annual Trico Renewable Percentage ("Usage Subject to Rider"). The Usage Subject to Rider will then be multiplied by the Rider Energy Charge (\$.01 per kWh), up to the amount of Customer's selected option.

The Customer may choose one of the following options under this Rider. The selected option, and its associated rates and/or charges shall be in addition to the rates and/or charges applicable in Customer's current rate schedule and any other applicable charges:

### **Option 1: Trico 50% Renewable**

50% of monthly usage is renewable power

Rider Energy Charge for such kWh	\$ .01 per kWh
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### **Option 2: Trico 100% Renewable**

100% of monthly usage is renewable power

Rider Energy Charge for all kWh	\$ .01 per kWh
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All other provisions and charges in the Customer's applicable rate schedule shall continue to apply.

## **Service Terms**

1. Renewable Power may be generated from: a) Trico-owned renewable resources; b) renewable resources included in power purchase agreements from which the Cooperative has purchased energy; or c) from any other another renewable energy resource that provides a Renewable Energy Certificate (REC) for each mWh of renewable energy purchased.
2. Customers may cancel participation in this Rider at any time. However, the Rider Energy Charge will continue until the next billing cycle after authorized notice of cancellation is received by Trico.
3. Customer cannot take service under more than one of the options listed above at the same time.
4. This Tariff shall be subject to change or termination by Trico, at Trico's discretion. In the event that RECs or Renewable Power become unavailable or impractical to obtain, Trico may suspend or terminate this Rider. In such case Customers shall be returned to their applicable Tariff.
