Frequently Asked Questions

1. How do I apply for a new project/development?

You can contact Trico's New Service Department at 520-744-2944 ext. 2731 or constructionapplications@trico.coop to start the application process.

2. How long does the Design process take?

It typically takes 2-3 months to complete the final design package with construction depending on project scope.

3. Is there a design deposit?

Typical commercial projects require a \$10,000 design deposit, larger projects may require 10% of the estimated total cost. Subdivision projects require a \$75 per lot design fee.

4. How much will my project cost?

A ballpark estimate will be provided during the preliminary design stage. See the following link for allowances given to commercial services and subdivisions.

5. What are the Developer construction responsibilities?

The developer provides all trenching and is responsible for supplying and installing primary/secondary conduit and concrete pads. The developer installs Trico provided basements and ground rods. All requirements are specified in Trico's Electric Service Requirements Book and Subdivision standard detail package.
